Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm - Phase 2 Public Exhibition and Consultation Launch

Dear Resident,

In November 2024, Eurowind Energy Limited held our first round of public consultation on the proposed Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm (formerly Carron Valley Wind Farm). We would like to thank everyone who attended the first round of public consultation and provided feedback. Local knowledge and community views are a vital part of developing our plans for any proposed site.

Since the first round of public consultation, we have reviewed the feedback received from residents, stakeholders and consultees. Alongside this, our technical and environmental assessments have progressed. We are now in the final stages of developing an updated scheme design that is cognisant of the feedback received. The project, now renamed **Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm**, will consist of four wind turbines capable of generating up to 30 Megawatts of renewable energy. Following feedback from the first round of public consultation, the design has been updated to lower turbine heights and adjust their placement.

We have now launched a second round of public consultation to share our changes and gather your feedback. This next consultation period will run from **23rd March 2026** to **24th April 2026**.

As part of this process, we are hosting two further public drop-in exhibitions, giving residents and stakeholders the opportunity to talk directly with the project team, view the latest plans, and share feedback.
