Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm - Phase 3 Public Exhibition and Consultation Launch

Dear Resident,

In March and April 2026, Eurowind Energy Limited held our second round of public consultation on the proposed Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm (formerly Carron Valley Wind Farm). We would like to thank everyone who attended the second round of public consultation and provided feedback. Local knowledge and community views are a vital part of developing our plans for any proposed site.

Since the second round of public consultation, we have reviewed the feedback received from residents, stakeholders and consultees. Alongside this, our technical and environmental assessments have progressed and are almost complete. The proposed Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm, will consist of four wind turbines capable of generating up to 30 Megawatts of renewable energy.

We have now launched a third round of public consultation to share the most up to date proposals and gather your feedback. This next, and final, consultation period will run from **25th May 2026** to **19th June 2026**.

As part of this process, we are hosting one further public drop-in exhibition, giving residents and stakeholders the opportunity to talk directly with the project team, view the latest plans, and share feedback.
