

## **Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm: Public Exhibition 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2026**

Eurowind Energy Limited, invites you to attend a Public Exhibition event at which the latest draft proposals for the Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm (formerly Carron Valley Wind Farm) will be presented. The proposed Cairnoch Hill Wind Farm is located on land at Cairnoch Hill, immediately north of the Carron Valley Reservoir in Stirling. Current proposals for the Site comprise four wind turbines, each with a maximum blade tip height of up to 180m, along with ancillary infrastructure.

The Public Exhibitions will be held as follows:

The Public Exhibition will provide an opportunity to gain information about the proposals and how they have progressed following the previous Public Exhibitions held in March and April of 2026. Visualisations of how the wind farm may look if constructed will be presented, as well as various other Figures showing different elements of the proposed development. Detail on feedback received from the previous Public Exhibitions and how this has been considered will also be provided.

You will be invited to provide comments and feedback on the proposals as part of the consultation process. Members of the Eurowind team will be in attendance to field any questions that you may have whilst visiting the exhibitions.
